

CHARGING THE BATTERY

1) Check the status of the battery while it is in use by pressing the Test Button on the side of the battery pack. The Test LED Indicator status will be displayed for 2 seconds.

GREEN LED: the battery has enough power to properly operate the furniture.

RED LED: the battery pack needs to recharge.

2) If the Test LED Indicator is red, connect the AC Power Supply Cord to the battery pack and plug into a wall outlet for charging.

Operating the battery while charging is permitted, but may require a longer charging time before the battery is fully charged.

3) While charging, the Charge LED Indicator will remain on to show the charging status.

RED LED: Battery is charging.

GREEN LED: Battery is fully charged.


