

#### CHARGING THE BATTERY

1) Check the status of the battery by pressing the Test Button

If the LED does not light up, the battery is in sleep mode and will wake up automatically once charging.

2) If the Test LED Indicator is red or amber, connect the AC Power Supply Cord to the battery pack.

3) Plug the AC Power Supply into a wall outlet.

4) Charge until the Charge LED is green. Allow up to 7 hours for a full charge.

Note: Operating furniture while charging may require a longer charging time.

Do not allow the battery to completely drain as this may reduce the life of the battery.

5) Once fully charged, unplug

the battery from the wall outlet.

### TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

#### No Power Output from Battery Pack

1) Confirm the battery pack is awake and the connections between the battery and furniture are secure

To exit sleep mode, press and hold the Test Button for five seconds until the Test and Charge LEDs turn green.






